

Amenities

BATHHOUSES: Cleaned daily. In order to do the best job possible, we must close them completely. We appreciate your cooperation during these times and regret any inconvenience.

SWIMMING POOL:

- Pool Hours: 10:00 am - 9:00 pm; Memorial Day - October
- POOL IS CLOSED IF THERE IS THUNDER OR LIGHTNING. It will re-open 30 to 60 minutes after the thunder stops.
- CHILDREN under 14 years must be accompanied by an adult.
- NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY
- No smoking in the pool area. No eating or drinking while IN the pool. No glass containers in the pool area.

DRY SAUNA: No eating or drinking in the sauna. No children permitted in the dry sauna.

HIKING TRAIL: Map available at the office

DISHWASHING STATIONS: 4 stations are located around the park.

FILTERED WATER: is available at the dishwashing stations.

LAUNDRY: There are no guest laundry facilities on the property.

OUTDOOR GAMES: We offer Cornhole, Horseshoes, Ping Pong, Basketball. Game accessories are available throughout the park. Please return items when you are finished. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

Resort Rules

A violation of any of the Resort Rules may be used as grounds to remove a guest from the Resort without a refund.

SPEED LIMIT IS 5 MPH-Strictly enforced!

GUESTS / VISITORS: Registered guest must report any additional guests/visitors/-vehicles to office within 30 minutes of arrival. Additional parking permit(s) are available for purchase at office (subject to availability).

Approval prior to arrival is required for all visitors (non-overnight guest) and must register with office within 30 minutes of arrival. Subject to availability Sunday to Thursday 9AM TO 6PM ONLY. We do not issue same day requests for visitors/visitor parking passes during weekends, holidays, special events, or summer months, more information about groups and events gatherings listed below. Additional parking, if available, can be purchased at office. Unregistered vehicles will be towed at owner's expense.

CHILDREN: You are responsible for all conduct and safety of the children or minors with you. Unruly behavior may necessitate you having to leave the Resort without a refund. Children under the age of 16 must be always accompanied by an adult.

QUIET TIME: Quiet time is 9 PM to 7 AM. Please note: voices, and vehicle noises can echo loudly in the park. To ensure that all our guests have a great camping experience, our quiet time is strictly enforced. Please be respectful to other guests. Guests that continue to be loud after being asked to quiet down may be asked to leave the resort without a refund or may not be permitted to stay with us in the future.

VEHICLES: Each cabin, RV & Tent site comes with 1 parking spot. Never park a vehicle in an RV site. Parking for an additional vehicle or utility trailer may be purchased at the office for a fee of \$30 per night. Double fees are applied to unreported add-ons.

ATV's, 4Wheeler's, or Scooters are not allowed to be operated in the Resort.

GROUPS & EVENTS: All large parties, gatherings with guests not registered at park, events, and private business operations not affiliated with Saddle Mountain are prohibited. Any/all unregistered visitors of guests will be asked to leave and non-registered vehicles required to be immediately removed from property. Violation of this policy will result in a minimum fine of \$100. Without prior written approval from SMR management, any on-site lodging (cabins, tent cabins, yurts) and sites (RV and tent) are prohibited to be used as main gathering area for guests not listed on lodging or site reservation. If your reservation is made with multiple lodging accommodations and/or sites and you desire to use one as your gathering area you must submit a formal email with a detailed request at least 2 weeks prior to check in to allow ample time for management to review.

GOLF CARTS: Golf carts are not permitted.

PETS: Pets are welcome. All animals must be always on a leash no longer than 6 ft and under adult supervision. Never leave pets alone outside. All pet waste must be picked up immediately, bagged and disposed of. Aggressive or constantly barking animals are not allowed. Guests who disobey pet rules, may be asked to leave the Resort. Please see the RVPM Dog Policy for the complete policy.

SAFETY PROCEDURES: Please do not feed the Wildlife! Don't leave food waste in plastic trash bags at site overnight. In case of emergency, call 911 and contact camp host or manager immediately. Be smart and enjoy your stay! We reserve the right to ask guests to leave for any reason. We recommend bringing a flashlight due to the limited lighting around the property.

CAMPFIRES / FIRE PITS: NO CAMPFIRES!!! NO BURNING WOOD!!! Charcoal, Propane or Duraflame logs (wax logs) only! Violators caught burning wood will be asked to leave without a refund. If evidence of wood burning is found, you will not be permitted to stay at our resort in the future. DO NOT burn anything in a propane fire pit. Please call for assistance lighting the propane fire pit if needed.

GARBAGE: Household garbage only allowed. Please take large trash bags to the nearest trash can. Recycling Dumpster is for collapsed cardboard, plastic & glass bottles and cans. DO NOT PUT COALS FROM BBQ OR ASHES FROM FIREPIT IN ANY DUMPSTER!! Our staff will empty out coals and ashes between site rentals.

ALCOHOL: If taken off your site, must be concealed in a foam insulator or plastic cup.

RV CONNECTION: All RVs must have a proper electrical power cord and sewer hose seal. Solid sewer connections and water pressure regulators are a must.

SITE APPEARANCE: No hanging laundry out, except wet towels. Do not leave food out and put trash in cans immediately. Pick up site before leaving and return picnic table to original location in site. Sites left with excessive trash and/or damages to the site itself are subject to an incidental fine charged to card on file.

ON-SITE RV REPAIR WORK OR RV WASH: No mechanical work or washing/detail work is allowed on RVs unless performed by an authorized and insured technician with management approval. All vendors must sign in at the office upon arrival.

CAMPER COURTESY / CONDUCT:

- Do not walk or ride bikes on other sites.
- Respect the privacy of your neighbors.
- Bikes and roller blades are permitted on the road only during daylight hours.
- Guests are expected to exercise good sense and respect for others.

NOT PERMITTED:

- Smoking on property
- No fireworks
- Clotheslines
- No OIL CHANGES anytime in the Resort
- No one is allowed to operate a business from within the Resort
- Subletting is not allowed

NOTICE: Pursuant to California Civil Code Section 799.20 et seq., a recreational vehicle may be removed from the premises without a judicial hearing after a 72-hour notice. If owner or occupants of said vehicle, who has been in park for 30 days or less, has either failed to pay his/her occupancy in the park or (2) failed to comply with park's rules and regulations. Traffic Law Enforcement Agency 659-2021. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone and will not be responsible for accidents or injury to guests for loss of money or valuables of any kind.

We enforce our rules to protect our guests. Failure to comply with the resort rules may result in removal from the resort. We reserve the right to refuse service to any rig based on appearance and/or condition.

Management is not responsible for loss, bodily injury, or damage of personal property caused by fire, force of nature, theft or accidents. RV Owners are responsible for all damages caused by themselves or their visitors.
